Deadlines

The deadline for applications is Sept. 1, 2009. Any application received after Sept. 1 will incur a \$50 late fee which must be included with your application.

Camping

The NRA Whittington Center has 2 RV campgrounds, total of 125 sites, with full hookups and all spaces are considered "pull through." A bathhouse and laundry facilities are available. At the Coors Range, where the CBA Nationals is being held, 20 RV spaces are available. These spaces are equipped with electric only.

Lodging

Raton is 7 miles from the Whittington Center and has 21 motels/hotels. Some of the major chains represented are Holiday Inn Express, Comfort Inn, Super 8, Motel 6 and Microtel.

Transportation

Nearest airport would be Albuquerque which is 3 hours south of Raton or Denver which is 4 hours north. Service to Raton is also available by Amtrak or Greyhound. Please note that Amtrak and Greyhound does not allow firearms, ammo or components to be transported by rail or bus. If you are planning to use these modes of transportation you will need to make arrangements to have you equipment shipped.

BJ's Shootin' Shop in Raton has offered to handle any guns that need to be shipped for the National tournament. There will be no charge for this service. BJ's contact information is P.O. Range Rules

Will be included in your conformation packet.

National Championship Point System

There will be a national champion declared for each class of competition. To qualify as a class, at least 10% of the competitors at the Tournament must shoot in the class. Additionally there will be a National Tournament Grand Championship Trophy awarded by a point system. The total number of points awarded will be 6 per class times the number of qualifying classes. For example, if four classes qualify, a total of 24 (6 x 4) points per aggregate will be awarded. Those 24 points will be allocated to the classes based on the percentage of shooters in each class. Points are then awarded to competitors placing in all 100 yard, 200 yard and 100-200 aggregates on the basis of on the basis of 3 points, or all the points allotted to the class whichever is smaller, for the winner and a smaller number for runner up, etc. The maximum possible point total for a shooter that won all nine aggregates in their class would be 27 (3 X 9). The National Grand Champion will be the person accumulating the most points. In case of a tie, the competitor shooting in the class with the most entries will be the winner. Example: (actual numbers for any tournament will be computed from number of entries).
