GRAND NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP TROPHY

The Grand National Championship Trophy will be awarded for the highest standings based on 120 record shots fired for group and score, with 60 shots at 100 yards and 60 shots at 200 yards. Points will not be awarded in the standing match. Shooting will be for prizes only. In order to be eligible for awards, each rifle or pistol class must have a minimum of 10% of the total entrants.
